Internet Acceptable Use Agreement:

The District’s Acceptable Use Agreement provides guidelines for computer and internet use. A student’s internet access may be revoked if any of the following expectations are not met:

1. It is the policy of School District 42 to maintain a school environment free of harassment based on race, color, religion, national origin, age, gender, sexual orientation, disability, or any other characteristic protected by law. Students shall observe this policy in the use of the Network. Employ digital etiquette by using appropriate, non-abusive language, refrain from making defamatory remarks or racial slurs, bullying, and from the use obscene or profane language.
2. Students should not become involved in online activities or discussions that are illegal or ill suited, or that may expose them to individuals wishing to make inappropriate contact with students.
3. Students will not use the Internet for any product and/or service advertisement or political lobbying.
4. The student and parent will not hold the teacher, school or District liable for any materials retrieved from the Internet.
